Nebraska Fuel Tax Rate

The second quarter 2017 fuel rate (April 1, 2017-June 30, 2017) is \$0.2730. The rate for the third quarter 2017 (July 1, 2017 through September 30, 2017) will be \$0.2700.

Reminder to pay the 2017/2018 Federal Heavy Use Tax - Form 2290

Anyone who registers a vehicle with a combined gross weight of 55,000 pounds or more must file Form 2290 and pay the tax. Although the IRS encourages all 2290 filers to e-file, if you are reporting 25 or more heavy highway vehicles, you are required to e-file through an IRS-approved software provider. Use e-file and your Schedule 1 is available almost immediately after IRS accepts it. No more waiting for it to come in the mail, which is very helpful when it comes time to renew your trucks. https://www.irs.gov/uac/e-file-form-2290

Are you an Owner/Operator leasing your services?

This is a reminder to always keep a copy of your mileage and fuel records before turning them over to the company you are leased to. It is not unusual for an owner/operator to break lease and want to start their own IRP account or, lease on to another company but can't provide the previous mileage and fuel history. This is a show-stopper and will slow down the registration process while tracing back the mileage history.

From the Audit Desk

Records Retention - all mileage and fuel records used to support the IFTA returns must be retained for four years. All mileage records used to support the IRP renewals must be retained for five years. This includes D.O.T. logs and GPS records if you are using them as your mileage source documents for IFTA and IRP.
